Question: If my child is 18 and still in school, can they apply for themselves?

Answer: Yes. Your child is able to apply as they are an adult and can receive their own check.

Question: What do I need to attach to my application?

Answer: You will need to attach an acceptance letter. Also, proof of physical custody/guardianship. Acceptable documents include:

- Most recent custody order
- School records including students name, parent/guardian's name and a physical address
- Child support court order
- TANF verification letter
- Income tax returns
- State Dept. of Social Services & Medical Benefits Letter/Forms
- Rental Lease Agreement which lists adult, child & physical address

Question: When will my check be ready?

Answer: Applications could take at least two weeks for processing.

Question: Can another individual pick up my check for me?

Answer: Yes, as long as you verify with the Covid EFA office that you give permission for that individual to pick up your check for you.

Question: Will all of my children, who are approved, be on one check?

Answer: Each child will have their own check under the parent/guardian's name.

Question: Will off reservation students in pre-k, secondary and homeschool be eligible for the Education Grant application?

Answer: Yes, all tribal members in pre-k, secondary and homeschool are eligible for the Education Grant application.

Question: If my child is in day care are they eligible for the Education Grant application?

Answer: No, day care students are not eligible.

Question: If my child is in early head start are they eligible for the Education Grant application?

Answer: Yes, your child is eligible.

Question: Is there a deadline to apply?

Answer: No, there is no deadline established as of right now.

Question: How will I know if my application is incomplete?

Answer: The Covid EFA office will call or email the applicant if the application is incomplete.
